Certificate II in Community Services— Children’s Services (CHC22015)

This course is recognised preparation for a broad range of careers in health and care industries. It includes an overview of the industry, senior first aid and other units of competence from the training package.

The focus is children but the course caters for an interest in other industries including, aged care, nursing, disability. Pathways include employment in Child Care facilities or further study at TAFE in Certificate III.
