### Format:

1 day per week for a full year—commences Week 2, Term 1 2018  
140 hours structured work placement (4 weeks) required as part of TGSS requirements—students to arrange and keep a record of hours

### Course Fee:

\$300

Training costs are subsidised by the Training Guarantee for SACE students, pending eligibility.

Students will be required to arrange a DCSI Screening at an additional cost of \$15 with their home school.

### Selection Criteria/Student Requirements:

Applicants must be aged 16 years or older, have a DCSI clearance, and have undertaken VET, work placement or employment relating to this qualification prior to applying. Applications are subject to a thorough pre-training review including LLN assessment and suitability interview.
